of the Soviet Union Mexico City, Mexico.

I was unable to remain in Mexico City ~~for~~
~~several~~ ~~months~~ indefinitely because of my ~~own~~
Mexican visa restrictions which was for 15 days
only. ~~Therefore~~ I could not ~~apply~~ ~~for~~ ~~an~~ ~~extension~~ ~~unless~~
I used my real name as I returned to the U.S.
and ~~my~~ ~~name~~ ~~is~~ ~~now~~ ~~living~~ ~~in~~
Dallas, Texas, ~~with~~ ~~my~~ ~~wife~~

The FBI is not now interested in my
activities in the progressive organization, F.P.C.
of which I was secretary in ~~the State of~~
Louisiana and I am no longer ~~interested~~ ~~in~~
that State.

~~Therefore~~ ~~the~~ ~~FBI~~ ~~has~~ ~~made~~
no lead in Texas on Nov. 1st. agent of the FBI
James P. Hooley warned me that if I attempted to engage
in F.P.C. activities in Texas the FBI will again take
an "interest" in me. He stated that "suggested" that my
wife would remain in the U.S. under FBI protection,
that so, she could ~~depart~~ ~~from~~ ~~the~~ ~~Soviet~~ ~~Union~~.
Of course I and my wife strongly protested

~~It was unfortunate that the Soviet Embassy was unable to aid me in Mexico City and I had not planned to contact the Mexican City Embassy at all so of course they were unprepared for me and I had been able to reach Havana as planned I could have contacted the Soviet Embassy there for the completion of ~~which I had been able to~~ ~~get the necessary documents as required.~~ ~~assist me.~~ would have had the time to assist me. but of course the ~~my~~ strip Cuban Consul was at fault here, I'm glad he has since been replaced by another.~~
