all other bills.

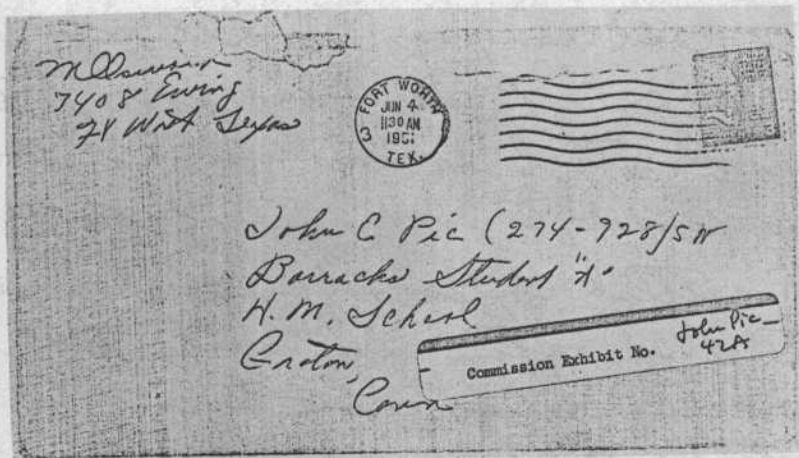
I owe Maggie a letter. Expect
