TCM FERRYMAN

Was at home when President was shot. Arrived at station in about ten minutes. Everyone had gone out in mobile units, and the networks and literally hundreds of stations were clamouring for feeds. He and everyone who could be found - even weatherman Dale Milford - were feeding stations. Coffee and sandwiches were brought in. Left station about 2:30 A. M. Returned about 9:00 A. M. Saturday to resume constant feeds.

4:25

Saturday at the county jail for Oswald's transfer. Was interviewed by Radio Free Berlin. Oswald was not transferred as planned.

6:00

Went to county jail with recorder again Sunday morning to await Oswald's transfer.

7:10

Reporters at jail get news that Oswald has been shot. Crowd applauds.

8:30

Dashes to City Hall.

9:30

Reporters interviewing reporters in the hallway.

11:00

Hid a telephone behind a desk so he could keep a direct line open to NBC. Interviewed Tony Zoppi for a description of Jack Ruby - very fine interview.

12:35

Curry announces Oswald's death.

Went to Ft. Worth in Mobile Unit to cover President's speech outside Texas Hotel. Crowd in rain.

17:20

Connally appears.

17:50

President appears to screams of delight from teenagers. Makes brief speech.
